Legacy Awards Gala Table Ambassador Information

What am I supposed to do as a Table Ambassador?

It's actually quite easy, but *critical* to ensuring the success of the event.

As a Table Ambassador, you will invite nine people (friends, co-workers, peers, neighbors or family members) to join you at your table and enjoy a wonderful community gathering and celebration at El Centro de la Raza's Legacy Awards Gala. Guests are asked to contribute at least \$100 (ticket price) which will go towards covering event costs as well as assisting with our operating costs so that our programs can function to their fullest capacity in order to best support the community.

Start recruiting your guests right away! You don't need to have an invitation in hand to invite your friends. You can follow up with the invitation in late July. Most people are so busy, that several reminders are helpful. Reviewing the **Table Ambassador Timeline** (included in this packet) will give you a general idea of when you can expect to receive information from El Centro, and gives suggestions of good times to connect with your guests.

How do I find people to invite?

The quickest way is to go through your address book and identify people you know who care about civil rights, Dr. King's vision of building the "Beloved Community," or social justice issues. Send a personal invitation or a letter, make a phone call or send an email as a way to introduce them to El Centro and to invite them to be your guest. El Centro de la Raza will send you printed invitations in late July 2013.

When are guest lists and ticket payments due to El Centro de la Raza? Guest lists and payments are due on <u>Friday</u>, <u>August 31</u>, <u>2013</u>. Registration and payment can be done online at https://elcentro.ejoinme.org/registration.

As the Table Ambassador you can create a "group name" your guests should include in their registration. If registering online is not a possibility, guest lists can be faxed to (206) 329-0786, emailed to events@elcentrodelaraza.org, or mailed to El Centro de la Raza, 2524 16th Ave S. What do I actually do at the event?

Simply check in at the registration desk when you arrive. The registration desk will be in the lobby at the main entrance. Some Table Ambassadors like to wait in the lobby to see their guests arrive and point them in the right direction to their table. Most importantly, enjoy the event, talk about El Centro and have a good time with your friends!

Table Ambassador Timeline

Right Now!	Begin the process of recruiting potential guests to attend the Legacy Awards Gala.	
May	Save the Date cards will be mailed to you to be distributed to your potential guests.	
July	Join us for a special event to honor your role as a Table Ambassador! Details to follow. Printed and electronic invitations will be mailed to you to distribute to your guests. Directions on how to register online will be on the invitation. As the Table Ambassador you can create a "group name" your guests should include in their registration. www.legacyawardsgala.org	
August 1	Deadline for Table Ambassadors to confirm participation in the Legacy Awards Gala and to be recognized in the program booklet.	
Mid-August	Confirm with your guests. Call or email them to remind them of the date and time, and find out if they have any questions.	
August 22	Payment for table due to El Centro de la Raza. Registration and payment can be done online at www.legacyawardsgala.org .	
August 31	Ensure all your guests have registered online under your "group name" or email, fax or mail your guest list to El Centro de la Raza. We need your guest list at least 4 weeks before the Legacy Awards Gala to register your guests, and prepare their nametags and seating arrangements.	
September 5	Contact your guests and let them know you're looking forward to seeing them on October 5 th . Be sure you give them the directions to the Washington State Convention Center.	
September 24	Contact your guests to remind them of the Legacy Awards Gala. Make sure that they received the directions and parking info and know the time and location of the event.	
October 5th	Legacy Awards Gala! Please arrive at 4:50 pm to check in at the registration table, receive your packet of information and greet your guests.	
October 7th	Thank your guests for joining you at the celebration! If any of your guests were unable to attend, encourage them to contribute to El Centro de la Raza.
